2012 Financial Statement and Year in Review

Through your generous gifts to Wings of the Eagle, together we made a difference in the lives of many poor indigenous people in Mexico.

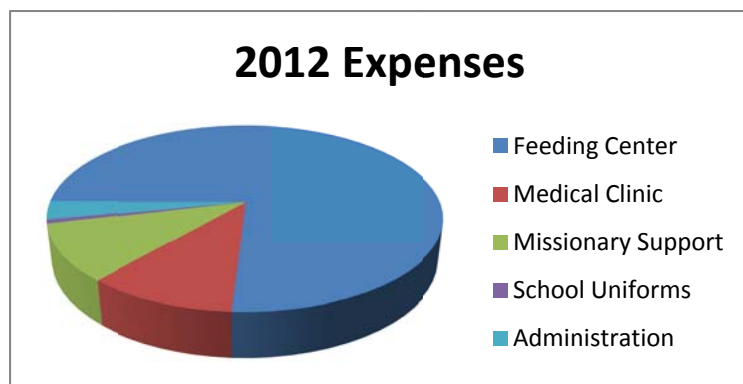
Highlights of 2012:

- Nutritious meals were served 5 days a week to an average of about 50 children, nursing mothers, and elderly each day. With an average of 22 feeding days per month, this amounts to about 13,200 meals served during the year.
- A monthly free medical clinic was held for the poor, staffed by a Mexican physician, Dr. Dulce Martinez, who is from Oaxaca. Prenatal exams for pregnant women were provided, and serious illnesses were treated.
- Medications were provided free of charge to the clinic patients. These have included antibiotics for potentially life-threatening infections, anti-parasite medications, prenatal vitamins for expectant mothers, cough, cold and flu remedies, and medications for stomach ailments and ear infections.
- Several eye patients from the colonia who could not otherwise afford treatment for their conditions, were transported by Pastor Frank & Detra to the annual “Heaven in Sight” free eye clinic, where one young patient had cataract surgery and others received treatment for strabismus.
- School uniforms, backpacks and supplies were provided for several indigenous children so that they could attend school.

We appreciate all that you have made possible in the past year. Here are some examples of what your donations can do:

- \$25 pays for needed prescription medications and vitamins for several needy patients
- \$30 will buy food to prepare a nutritious meal for approximately 50 indigenous children
- \$50 will buy school supplies required for a child to attend school
- \$100 pays for a Mexican physician to see patients at our clinic one day per month
- \$300 will pay for the cook’s salary to prepare meals for one month
