2013 Highlights and Financial Statement

Through your generous gifts to Wings of the Eagle, you made a difference in the lives of many poor indigenous people in Mexico. We appreciate all that you have done to make these things possible. Here are some highlights of 2013:

- Nutritious meals were served to children and nursing mothers who come from the nearby labor camps on the outskirts of Ensenada. With an average of 30 people served at each meal, about 5,548 individual meals were served during the year.
- Food staples (beans, rice, flour, oatmeal, and powdered soy milk) were given out on a weekly basis to approximately 23 families, and clean drinking water was made available 24 hours a day to many more. Small children often walk to Pastor Francisco & Detra's mission home to fill their containers with clean water for their families.
- Twenty free medical clinics were held for the poor, staffed by Mexican physician Dr. Dulce Martinez, who is from Oaxaca. Clinics are now held twice a month. Prenatal exams for pregnant women were provided, and serious illnesses were treated. Medications and vitamins were provided free of charge to the clinic patients.
- Eleven free Preventive Health Education classes were held, attended by an average of 14 women and teen moms at each session. Several of these were taught by Dr. Norma Prado, and four were dedicated to Early Childhood stimulation and screening, taught by nurse specialist Yolanda Ramirez.
- Sixteen women attended Adult Literacy classes, which were taught by trained volunteers, using curriculum and testing provided by the National Institute for Adult Education. Of these students, twelve passed their exams in December, which will allow them to progress to the next level of schooling. Five of these women had NO prior formal education.
- These outreaches provided many opportunities for Pastor Francisco and Detra to pray with, counsel and give Biblical teaching to dozens of individuals and families.
