### Lives are touched!


We would like to thank all our partners and provide a personal glimpse of what your partnership in this ministry is accomplishing in the lives of the precious people in Mexico who are receiving not only food and medical assistance, but hope and something of eternal value and significance. We want to share the experiences of two indigenous women and what they recently said about their own lives and the help they received through Wings of the Eagle ministry.

### Trinidad's story

First is the testimony of Trinidad, a woman who represents many other women in Mexico who, like her, are mothers of young children without the support of a husband and father in the home, and no other close relative to help. Just trying to survive, Trinidad was becoming desperate to find work and a place to take her two beautiful children so they could be cared for while she worked. She even considered giving them up and leaving them at an orphanage, until she came to Pastor Frank and Detra for help and counsel.

*"My life was getting very hard a few months ago. My husband left me with our two little girls and I had no job. I was going to go to San Lazaro for work and have to leave my babies somewhere, maybe not be able to come back for them. One*

*day the sister [Detra] started to talk to me about this and I was very, very sad. I cried a lot and hurt because at night sometimes my babies cried from being cold and not eating, I couldn't make milk for them and I was sad. But the sister told me that Yahweh had sent His Son Yeshua to die for me and to help me and she promised to help me with food and a doctor because my girls were sick more than the other girls. She prayed for me and since then I have a good job here and my friend cares for my babies while I work. Detra asked if she could put my picture on the computer and tell my story and I say "Yes." So other women like me can see what Yahweh does."*

**Theodora's story:**

*"I thank Yahweh my God for showing us, my whole family, how much He loves us this year. My husband was severely injured in his back and could not work. We, my husband, my three children and I were thrown out of housing that was provided by my husband's boss, with only two days notice. I went to Pastor Frank and his wife and they let us move in with them. We lived with them for six months and then they paid our first month's rent in a house in Maneadero. I do not know what we would have done without them. I was raised in church but never really believed in Jesus until all of this happened and He became real in my life. Yahweh is "No (a)o" (light) in my life now."*

Theo further explained that she is "holding tight to the trail or path of Jesus". She is now a great blessing to the ministry in helping other women and translating for Pastor Frank and Detra, since she is fluent in Spanish as well as her native Mixteco.

**Prayer requests**

We have become increasingly aware of the need for a volunteer dental team to come to the clinic to help the people in the surrounding labor camps. Please lift this need in prayer. If you know a dentist who might be interested in helping please have them contact us.

Please also keep the situation with the local indigenous workers in your prayers. There have been uprisings protesting low pay and poor working conditions. Some have turned violent, causing the Mexican police to crack down hard, arresting some of the local workers. Pray for a peaceful resolution that will be fair and just for all, and safety for Frank, Detra and the mission.

Just imagine—if there had been no one to help these ladies and their families, two little girls might now be living apart from their mother, not understanding why they were left. And what would have become of Theo's entire family, suddenly homeless with no job and a severe injury? But because of you, and God's provision, these precious ones were able to receive the help they desperately needed. They have personally experienced God's goodness and love, and are so grateful for what He has done for them.

**Clinic remodel**

New standards and requirements for medical clinics were set by the government in Mexico, which made it mandatory for our clinic building to be remodeled. A wheelchair ramp was added and other changes were made for added patient privacy, sanitation and comfort. The work has just now been completed at a cost of about \$2000. If you would like to give to help meet this financial need, we would be very grateful.
